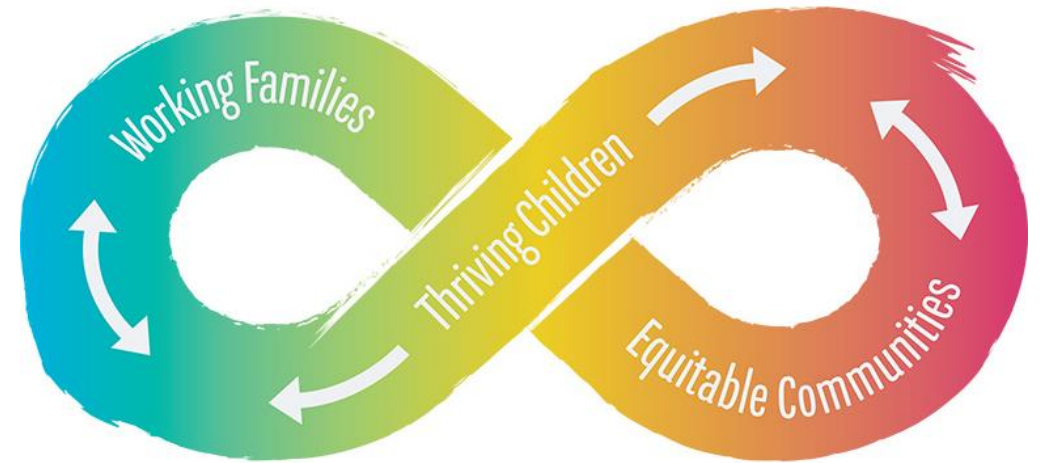
About the W.K. Kellogg Foundation

Haiti's Readiness to Engage in CARIGEO

- Lack of consistent data collection infrastructure: Haiti's last general census was in 2003
- Limited availability of demographic and socio-economic data at national level and almost no data at the local level.
- Limited resources at Haiti Institute of Statistics and Informatics (*IHSI - French*)
- Political instability and civil unrest are impacting the operations of public institutions, including IHSI.
- The National Geo-Spatial Information Center (*CNIGS - French*) has been active in UN-GGIM Americas and the INEGI-Caribbean Initiative.
- CNIGS has reached out to civil society organizations like Association for the Development of Fondèblan to build a network to address Haiti's data and geo-spatial needs.





Our Shared Vision

- Systemic & regular data collection – national data hub/center
- Availability of data at all levels (national, departmental, local)
- Regional and local collaboration (academic, government and private institutions)
- Opportunity for knowledge transfer and technical assistance
- Including civil society organizations in CARIGEO Committee and as leading participant organizations



Our Current Support

- Grant to assist government of Haiti to develop a data system and framework to collect data and track progress towards achieving the Sustainable Development Goals.
- Collaboration between the United Nations Statistics Division (UNSD), Esri, IHSI, CNIGS, & Pvblic Foundation.
- Preparing to implement Federated Information System for the SDGs (FIS4SDGs)
- Conduct preliminary data and geo-spatial information capacity assessment.
