The **United Nations World Geospatial Information Congress (UNWGIC)** will provide a 'global geospatial stage' for multi-stakeholder and multi-industry participation by all actors to demonstrate capability, enhance communication, grow understanding, develop knowledge, and showcase the application of geospatial information management to address local, regional and global challenges. The UNWGIC is being organized by the **United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs** with the support of the **Government of China** through the **Ministry of Natural Resources** in collaboration with the **Government of Zhejiang Province in Deqing, China** from **19-21 November 2018**.

With an overarching theme **'The Geospatial Way to a Better World'** the UNWGIC will be a truly global event bringing together all stakeholders at the highest level to address and ensure that geospatial information has its widest and fullest utility in service of social, economic and environmental development.
