

Background

This workshop will focus on international geospatial standards capacity building for representatives from the Caribbean region. Based on the UN-GGIM Core Standards guide and other materials, the goals of the workshop include;

- Introduction to OGC and International Geospatial Standards
- Presentation of the UN-GGIM Core Standards Guide
 - > What are the standards associated with each level and what do they do?
 - > What are the key applications/use cases for my country?
 - What level of capacity does my country have?
 - What level of capacity does my country want?
- Discussion amongst delegates on potential regional cooperative applications/use cases
- Maintain an open environment throughout intended to foster a vibrant discussion amongst delegates.

Preparation

Delegates are expected to work with stakeholders in their respective countries to identify priority applications/use cases before the workshop. Monday will primarily consist of delegates creating and presenting results of a self-evaluation (see agenda below for more details). Presentations are expected to be no more than 5 Minutes.

A laptop capable of running power point is required. A presentation template and more information on the self-evaluation process will be provided prior to the workshop. Presentations will be compiled for potential further analysis by the workshop sponsors.
