Main Conference Agenda (17 - 19 August, 2011)

The main conference programme of Latin American Geospatial Forum shall consist of a number of sessions spread across three days covering a variety of topics on technology trends, policy reforms and end user applications.

Opening Session: Latin American Geospatial Forum shall have high profile political, administrative, academic, and industry representative to address Opening Session.

Plenary Session: This session shall have prominent personalities representing global geospatial industry, enterprise level user organisations, academia and Government agencies sharing their thoughts on latest developments and future trends.

Symposia: Latin American Geospatial Forum shall have four day-long Symposia on important aspects of geospatial technology developments and various industry verticals like mining and exploration, agriculture and environment, utility and infrastructure and Spatial Data Infrastructure.


